## SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

## RATIONALE:

Region I Board of Directors maintains that a comprehensive high school education must include opportunities for student participation in organized and competitive athletic and academic programs. It is our belief that the discipline and challenges of finding success in the competitive arena is also critical in achieving lifetime goals.

Region I will provide eight \$1000 scholarships for four male and four female students to pursue postsecondary education or vocational education. It is our objective to encourage senior high school students who have athletic and academic achievement to further their education. The scholarship will be awarded each spring in the form of a certificate. A letter from the winning applicant with their official class list attached is all that is required to receive the check, which will be written directly to them.

## Persons eligible to apply are: (applicant must meet <u>all</u> three requirements)

A. Alaska high school seniors attending Region I schools that seek to pursue post-secondary education or vocational training and who will be enrolled full time or have been accepted to such a program.

- B. Students who have been active participants in ASAA sanctioned and sponsored activities.
- C. Students who have demonstrated academic achievement and/or potential for success in college or vocational training.

All interested applicants <u>must</u> submit the following documents with their completed application form (**It is strongly recommended that the application be typed and a picture attached**):

- 1. Official grade transcript (most recent);
- 2. Written evidence of acceptance from school for which scholarship is requested; and
- 3. Three (3) letters of recommendation from people who have known the applicant for at least one (1) year.

Applications must be received by the Region I Scholarship Committee by **March 12, 2019**. If mailing it must be received by **March 8, 2019** Applications can also be hand delivered by a Region 1 member to the Executive Secretary by the date noted above.
